

## Healthy Pup Checklist

Veterinarian - Choose a type of vet that best suits your style. There are varieties from holistic to the Humane Society.

Shots - Most puppies come with their first round of shots that they should receive around 6-8 weeks old.

Spay or Neuter - lots of opinions on this subject. Ask your breeder what they recommend. 6-9 months old is pretty average.

Microchip - a tiny glass capsule the size of a grain of rice injected into your dog's skin for tracking. Average 1 time fee of \$45.

Trainer/Obedience School - Your local PetSmart and Humane Society offer classes. Local groups and schools are easy to find online or by asking friends. Tons of YouTube videos and websites are also helpful.

Groomer - Sheepadoodles coats are pretty easy to care for, PetSmart does a great job or Google or ask around for a groomer near you. Make sure you are clipping your puppy's nails and brushing their teeth regularly and early on so they get used to it at home.

Dog Walker - Find a dependable one by checking profiles and reviews on sites like care.com or dogwalker.com

Pooper Scooper - Google it to find a good one.

12-14 weeks	Rabbies	None
14-16 weeks	DHPP	Coronavirus, Lyme Disease, Leptospirosis
12-16 months	DHPP, Rabies	Coronavirus, Leptospirosis, Bordatella, Lyme Disease
Every 1-2 years	DHPP	Coronavirus, Leptospirosis, Bordatella, Lyme Disease
Every 1-3 years	Rabies	None
